## FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST - CC 09-036

This letter acknowledges receipt of your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request. Your request was transferred to our office from the Headquarters office in Washington, DC on August 17, 2009, and was received in our office on August 19, 2009. You requested the following records:

"Copies of all railroad and truck transportation logs, shipping papers, shipping manifests, etc. for any equipment shipped from AEC facilities, such as but not limited to, Savannah River, Georgia, and Oak Ridge, Tennessee, to the Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant (PGDP), located in McCracken County, Kentucky, from January 1951 thru July 1952. Include the point of origin and the dates delivered to PGDP, or otherwise staged offsite prior to final delivery to PGDP. Include staging of equipment within the city limits of Paducah, Kentucky, between the dates mentioned above."

Your FOIA request has been forwarded offsite to our Portsmouth/Paducah Project Office to conduct a search of its files for responsive documents. Upon completion of the search and the review of any documents that may be located, you will be provided a response to your request.

Our Headquarters FOIA office has granted a fee waiver and denied expedited processing of your request, therefore, no search and reproduction fees will be assessed in processing your records request. Your FOIA request will be processed under the DOE policy to process requests on a first-in, first-out basis. We will make every effort to process your request as soon as possible. The above-referenced number has been assigned to the request and you should refer to it in any correspondence with DOE about this matter.
